I found myself sticking up for my brothers with my parents but of course, we still argue a lot among ourselves.

As I reflect back, I learned a lot of interesting and helpful things. For example, I started cooperating with my brothers to do our household chores. We, each had to help out since we had one less person in the house and still the same amount of work everyday. I learnt to appreciate my family and my friends a lot more as I saw how easily I can lose someone I love. Something things I'm still working on are little responsibilities like finishing my work before enjoying myself with my free time. Ana would always give me the friendly reminder well in time and for those odd times, she would stick up for me so I never got in trouble with my parents. I miss her so much when it comes to looking at our pictures or writing and talking about her. She always used to give me big hugs and make amazing food for me (... and for the whole family)! Now I have to listen to my parents and my brothers instead of her. She always had a wonderful way to say everything. Looking forward, I am doing good and I'm happy with my family and friends and my home. Sometimes I think of Ana and I find myself smiling as I think of the fun times I had with her. Sometimes it brings tears and sometimes it makes me smile. But that's the balance and I am ever so thankful for those wonderful times and memories.

Even though I was born at the Good Samaritan Hospital, I never want to see that place ever again. It had made life hard for me and made me become a totally different person.
